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- I. We should rejoice in our sufferings because suffering produces endurance (v. 3b).
- II. We should rejoice in our sufferings because endurance produces proven character (v. 4a).
- III. We should rejoice in our sufferings because proven character produces hope (v. 4b).
 - A. The result of hope: We will not be put to shame on Judgment Day (v. 5a).
 - B. The reason for the result: God's love poured out to us through the Holy Spirit, His gift to us (v. 5b, c).

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
