

In Romans 5:15-19 Paul explains how Adam is a type of Christ by comparing and contrasting Adam and Christ.

I. Adam and Christ are different:

- A. Christ's free gift is not like Adam's trespass (v. 15).
- B. The result of Christ's free gift is not like the result of Adam's trespass (v. 16).
- C. The reign through Christ and His free gift is not like the reign through Adam and His trespass (v. 17).

II. Adam and Christ are similar:

- A. Adam worked, and his disobedience resulted in making all those who are in him to be sinners under condemnation (vs. 18a, 19a).
- B. Christ worked, and his obedience resulted in righteousness, justification, and life for all who are in Him (vs. 18b, 19b).
