

In Romans 8:1-4 Paul answers 4 questions about his promise that there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus (v. 1).

- I. *Why is there now no condemnation?*
Because believers have been set free from the law of sin and the law of death (v. 2).
- II. *Why is there condemnation in the first place?*
Because unregenerate human beings are incapable of obeying the law so the law cannot produce righteousness (v. 3b).
- III. *How was the need for condemnation overcome?*
By God sending His Son into the world as a sin offering to condemn sin (v. 3a, c).
- IV. *What is the purpose for which believers are not condemned?*
So that the righteous requirement of the law would be fulfilled in those who walk according to the Spirit (v. 4).
