

In Romans 8:31-39 Paul answers 5 crucial questions concerning God's love for His people.

I. What shall we say to the fact that we have hope because of the many results & benefits of justification found in Romans 5-8 (8:31a)?

Answer: Since God is for us no one can stand against us (8:31b).

II. Will God leave us without the resources to live until Jesus returns (8:32b)?

Answer: Absolutely not! He gave His Son as a propitiatory sacrifice on our behalf, did He not (8:32a)?

III. Is there anyone who will be able to bring a charge against us on Judgment Day (8:33a)?

Answer: Absolutely not! God has already pronounced us "not guilty" (8:33b).

IV. Is there anyone who will be able to pronounce us guilty on Judgment Day (8:34a)?

Answer: Absolutely not! Jesus has died, has been raised, has been enthroned in power, and continually intercedes for us that His work results in our "not guilty" verdict (8:34b).

V. Can anyone or anything separate us from this wondrous love (8:35)?

Answer: Absolutely not! Because of this wondrous work of Christ, nothing will ever separate us from God's love for us in Christ Jesus our Lord (8:36-39)!
