

In Mark 10:1-12 we find Jesus on the way to Jerusalem and involved in 5 instances of teaching and testing.

- I. Jesus teaches the crowds (v. 1).
- II. The Pharisees test Jesus (v. 2).
- III. Jesus tests the Pharisees (v. 3).
- IV. The Pharisees fail their test (v. 4).
- V. Jesus teaches the Pharisees the truth about divorce and remarriage.
  - A. Hardness of heart causes people to divorce (v. 5).
  - B. But God intends marriage to be permanent:
    1. God created and joined (vs. 6-8),
    2. So man must not separate (v. 9).
  - C. If a man or woman divorces their spouse then remarrying causes adultery so it is forbidden (vs. 10-11).
